

Pennsbury Retains No. 1 Spot in Poll

It was a fairly formful week for The Inquirer's Top 20 teams. Only one-19th-ranked West Chester-lost and another-16th-ranked Woodrow Wilson-was tied.

No. 20 Coatesville beat West Chester, 29-26, and moved to 18th; Lenape tied Wilson, 14-14, dropping the Tigers out of the Top 20.

No. 1 Pennsbury smashed Allentown Dieruff, 50-6. No. 2 St. James had no trouble with Roman Catholic and No. 4 Monsignor Bonner won handily over Archbishop Carroll. Malvern Prep, No. 5, had one of its toughest games of the year but escaped with a victory over Germantown Academy.

The big test this week is for No. 6 Abington, which faces 10th-ranked Plymouth-Whitemarsh.
