

## Palmyra Makes Its Debut Among Top 20

It was another true-to-form week as only two of the Inquirer's Top 20 teams lost.

Plymouth-Whitemarsh (No. 10) dropped a 20-14 decision to sixth-ranked Abington but each team retained its spot in

the poll this week.

Holy Spirit (No. 8) lost a 34-7 shocker to Millville and dropped out of the Top 20. Palmyra took advantage of Holy Spirit's misfortune and moved into 20th. The Burling-

ton County League power defeated Riverside, 26-6, for its fifth straight victory.

The top seven teams all scored impressive victories. No. 1 Pennsbury walloped Council Rock, 37-8; No. 2 St.

James crushed Archbishop Carroll, 54-0; No. 3 Upper Merion downed Methacton, 28-8; No. 4 Monsignor Bonner thumped Roman Catholic, 41-6; No. 5 Malvern Prep blanked Roxborough, 27-0; No. 6 Abington defeated Plymouth-Whitemarsh, and No. 7 Central Bucks West turned back a tough Hatboro-Horsham eleven, 22-15.

The biggest jump in the poll (11th to ninth) was made by Neshaminy, which routed Bensalem, 53-0, for its sixth straight win after an opening game loss.

Key games this week pit No. 3 Upper Merion against No. 6 Abington and No. 13 Archbishop Wood against No. 16 Bishop Kenrick.
