

CBW still No. 1, but N. J. gets a new leader

South Jersey has a new leader in this week's Inquirer Dunkel Ratings after the upset of top-rated Pennsauken by Cherry Hill East, and Central Bucks West solidified its hold on the

top spot in Pennsylvania after crushing North Penn for the Bux-Mont League title.

Pennsauken dropped to fourth place, one spot below Cherry Hill East, and Haddon Township became South Jersey's new leader, followed by Delsea, which posted an impressive victory over previously unbeaten Pennsville. Mainland and Cherokee, the sixth- and seventh-ranked teams respectively, will meet in the first round of the NJSIAA Group 3 playoffs this weekend.

In Pennsylvania's ratings, Cardinal O'Hara moved into a slim lead over Malvern Prep for second place on the heels of a lopsided win over Monsignor Bonner in the Catholic South-Suburban title game. Central Bucks West will be out to wrap up the No. 1 ranking in the final Dunkel Ratings when it tackles rival Central Bucks East, ranked 10th, on Thanksgiving Day.
